A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, ENDORSING THE PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE CONCEPT FOR NW 27TH AVENUE AND SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (“MPO”) TO DESIGN AND RECOMMEND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND TO ESTABLISH ELIGIBILITY FOR FEDERAL FUNDING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach (“City”) is an active participant with the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (“MPO”); and

WHEREAS, the MPO has included a project in its 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan to design and construct traffic calming, transit enhancements, crosswalks, pedestrian lighting, and landscaping along NW 27th Avenue from Atlantic Boulevard to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard (“Project”), within the City; and

WHEREAS, that NW 27th Avenue is functionally classified as a City road, which requires the City to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the road right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the MPO concept development efforts are intended as the first step to implementing the concept to identify, develop, prioritize, and implement transportation enhancement strategies; and

WHEREAS, the City and the MPO engaged the community through two public meetings and many stakeholder meetings to introduce the concepts and receive direction on the preferred alternative; and

WHEREAS, the MPO has completed the NW 27th Avenue Concept Plan, for the community’s preferred alternative; and

WHEREAS, the MPO requires a resolution from the City supporting the NW 27th Avenue Concept Plan in order to establish federal funding eligibility; and

WHEREAS, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered using the federally mandated Local Agency Program (“LAP”) process; and

WHEREAS, the City will be the agency responsible for the design, construction, and construction administration of the project under LAP; and

WHEREAS, the Project will further the City’s complete streets efforts and supports its objective to “ensure that a safe, convenient, resilient, equitable and energy efficient local multimodal transportation system is provided in an environmentally sound manner” to meet the demands of residents, travelers, and businesses; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2: The City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach, Florida, endorses the preferred alternative concept for NW 27th Avenue, as set forth in Exhibit A “Concept Plan”, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, and supports the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization’s efforts to prepare the recommended capital improvements for federal funding.

SECTION 3: That if any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, that remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
