Subject: Award Bid E-33-22 Kendall Lake Stormwater Improvements Project (Surtax Funded Project)

Contract Need/Background

Invitation to Bid (ITB) E-33-22 was issued to obtain bids to establish a contract to furnish and install a new complete stormwater collection system, reconstruction of the project roadways, swales, new landscape planting material, signage, and thermoplastic pavement markings located between NW 1st Ave (East boundary), NW 5th Terrace (West boundary), NW 21st Street (North boundary) and NW 16th Court (South boundary), in Pompano Beach, Florida. This work is required to improve surface water runoff and collection to provide safe passage of pedestrian and vehicular traffic throughout the area.

In accordance with section F.2. b., of the ITB, Stanford Construction Company was deemed non-responsible for not having performed similar type work in complexity and value. Bid award is recommended to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. Attached are the memorandum and the bid award recommendation form submitted by the Engineering Department, the bid tabulation, and solicitation document.

Bidders List

The Bidders List was created for companies/firms suggested by the requesting department, companies/firms that have responded to prior bids and companies/firms that have registered as bidders.

Advertising

The ITB was advertised in the Sun Sentinel, and notices were sent to bid notice agencies throughout the nation. The ITB was also posted on the City's eBid System for download by interested companies/firms and sent to all registered bidders by email.

Funding

\$1,868,311.15 of the project will be funded from budgeted funds in account 426-7569-538.65-12 (Capital Project / Kendall Lakes), and \$3,296,795.00 from Broward County surtax funds.

Award Recommendation

After reviewing the responses to the ITB with the Engineering Department, it is recommended an award for E-33-22 be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Man-Con, Incorporated, in the amount of \$5,165,106.15 for its bid.
