My name is Cynthia Foulke, my husband Larry and I reside at 964 SE 10th Court, Pompano Beach FL, 33060

We purchased our waterfront property in 1994 - on the West side of the Nancy Canal. We fell in love with the privacy, lush landscape and natural habitat behind our home. The natural line of Mangroves shields our view of the Accardi dealership, as well as helps to stop the erosion from the passing boats. Many species of birds have made our backyard their nesting and safe haven.

In 2006, a similar proposal was brought before this board, and the EPA, Senator Ellyn Bogdanoff, Gov. Jeb Bush and the Audubon Society were included in our fight to STOP the destruction of this natural habitat. We were successful then, and we are hoping for the same outcome again.

I am sending along many photos of the nesting Night Herons, the Egrets, Great Blue Herons and Storks - a Rookery for all of the birds.

Also Manatee have found their way to this sanctuary to munch on the mangroves at high tide. A beautiful large Florida Holly tree was broken during the last hurricane, but survived and is now thriving. (Mangrove and Holly are Florida native and can't be cut down).

The Nancy Canal is not wide enough to accommodate escalated boat traffic or boat docks - we were restricted when we built our boat lift.
