**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NW 5<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BETWEEN NW 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND NW 2<sup>ND</sup> STREET TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF ELLINGTON AVENUE AND NW 5<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE WITH NW 5<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by the Ellington Family, a pioneer family of Pompano Beach, by adding the name “Ellington Avenue” to a portion of NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA;**

**SECTION 1.** That the designation of a portion of NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue lying between NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Street shall have the dual designation of “Ellington Avenue” and NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, with NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County, so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
