A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2016-275 AND CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NORTHWEST 26TH AVENUE BETWEEN WEST ATLANTIC BOULEVARD AND NORTHWEST 2ND STREET TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF NORTHWEST 26TH AVENUE AND REV. JOHN L. MOHORN, JR. AVENUE WITH NORTHWEST 26TH AVENUE TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by Rev. John L. Mohorn, Jr. by adding the name "Rev. John L. Mohorn, Jr. Avenue" to a portion of Northwest 26th Avenue; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 2016-275 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of Northwest 26th Avenue lying between West Atlantic Boulevard and Northwest 2nd Street shall have the dual designation of Northwest 26th Avenue and "Rev. John L. Mohorn, Jr. Avenue" with Northwest 26th Avenue to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County, so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
