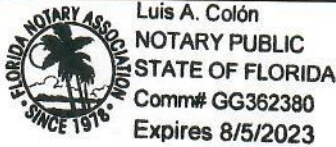

Pompano Beach Cemetery Burial Right Agreement No. 6708

THIS INDENTURE, made this 28 day of May, A.D., 2018 between CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Florida, and being in Broward County, Florida, Party of the First Part, and Mr. Roy Dobbins of the County of Broward and State of Florida Party of the Second Part, whose address is: 4236 Little Creek Rd. Dublin, VA 24084.

WITNESSETH, that the said Party of the First Part for and in consideration of the sum of \$0.00 to it in hand paid by the Party of the Second Part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby give and grant to the said Party of the Second Part, the exclusive and perpetual Right of Burial of the human dead in that certain parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Broward County, Florida, to wit:

Block 32 Lot 5 Plot 1,3 & 4 of Pompano Beach Cemetery South Lawn according to a plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 41, Page 40, of the public records of Broward County, Florida.

The Party of the Second Part does hereby agree that the premises above described shall remain under the perpetual care of the Party of the First Part in accordance with the Rules and Regulations now and hereafter in effect; and Party of the First Part hereby agrees that a true and correct copy of the current Rules and Regulations in existence shall be kept in the office of the Cemetery Management for inspection by Party of the Second Part at all reasonable times.
