A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2003-111; AND TO APPROVE CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NE 10TH STREET BETWEEN FEDERAL HIGHWAY AND DIXIE HIGHWAY TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF CENTENNIAL DRIVE AND NE 10TH STREET, WITH NE 10TH STREET TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission approved Resolution No. 2003-111 on January 28, 2003, recognizing the Pompano Beach Elks Lodge’s many contributions made by adding the name “Elks Lodge Drive” to a portion of Northeast 10th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Elks Lodge is no longer located on this road; and

WHEREAS, a name change has been requested for a certain right-of-way along NE 10th Street with a dual designation of Centennial Drive, which would serve to benefit the community and would represent the 100th anniversary of the City of Pompano Beach; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA;

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 2003-111 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

SECTION 2. That the designation of a portion of NE 10th Street lying between Federal Highway and Dixie Highway shall have the dual designation of “Centennial Drive” and NE 10th

Street, with NE 10th Street to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County, so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
