**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE
RETURNS OF THE MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION OF
THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, HELD ON
NOVEMBER 5, 2024 AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF
SAID ELECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Municipal General Election was held on November 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has received the returns of said election as presented by the City Clerk and the City Manager; said returns having been canvassed by the Broward County Canvassing Board; now therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO
BEACH, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. That the returns of the Municipal General Election held on November 5, 2024 be and the same are hereby accepted, a copy of said returns being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.

SECTION 2. That Rex Hardin, having been re-elected as shown on the returns referred to above is hereby declared to be officially elected to the position of Mayor.

SECTION 3. That Audrey Fesik, having been elected as shown on the returns referred to above is hereby declared to be officially elected to the position of Commissioner for District 1.

SECTION 4. That Rhonda Eaton (as reflected on the ballot), having been re-elected by default is hereby declared to be officially elected to the position of Commissioner for District 2.

SECTION 5. That Alison Lindsey Fournier, having been re-elected as shown on the returns referred to above is hereby declared to be officially elected to the position of Commissioner for District 3.

SECTION 6. That Beverly Perkins, having been re-elected as shown on the returns referred to above is hereby declared to be officially elected to the position of Commissioner for District 4.

SECTION 7. That Darlene H. Smith, having been elected as shown on the returns referred to above is hereby declared to be officially elected to the position of Commissioner for District 5.

SECTION 8. That in accordance with said returns, proposed Charter Amendment No. 1, amending Section 253 (h) of the City Charter of the City of Pompano Beach, is hereby declared approved and the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of the revised Charter with the Florida Department of State.

SECTION 9. That in accordance with said returns, proposed Charter Amendment No. 2, amending Section 251 (c) of the City Charter of the City of Pompano Beach, is hereby declared defeated.

SECTION 10. That in accordance with said returns, proposed Charter Amendment No. 3, amending Section 250 (a) and (b) of the City Charter of the City of Pompano Beach, is hereby declared defeated.

SECTION 11. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
