D. New Projects

2. Utility Wraps Round 3

Thirty-one (31) utility/traffic box locations remain to be wrapped. At the March 21, 2019 PAC meeting, the Call to Artists was approved. Staff was waiting renewal of the agreement with CAFÉ to post the Call. The Call was posted on August 21, 2019, with a deadline of October 15, 2019. 743 applications were submitted in response to this Call. The Committee voted online through CAFÉ to review and shortlist the 743 applications. Applications with a score less than 2.1 were eliminated; leaving eighty-three (83) applications to be reviewed at the November 2019 PAC meeting. The Committee will shortlist up to forty (40) applications that the Subcommittee will then select the top thirty-one (31) designs from. The Subcommittee will make recommendations on the utility box locations for each design and bring these recommendations to the Committee to review at a later date.

The bid for graphic design vendors was circulated. AD Graphics has been selected as the top-ranked vendor. An agreement between the City and AD Graphics has been completed. Public Works will pay the vendor fee and artist design fees will be paid from Public Art Program funding.
