Dear City Manager and City Commissioners:

I am respectfully requesting the naming and renaming of N.W. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Pompano Beach, FL 33060 to Bishop Douglas E. Russell, Sr. Street.

A community servant-leader and a respected entreprencur, Bishop Russell founded the first Black Landscaping business in Pompano Beach in 1949, based on integrity, honesty and hard work. His first contract was on Hillsboro Beach (Inlet) located in Deerfield Beach, FL in 1950 as a landscaper for residential properties. He was also a journeyman in the area of Electronics and repairing technology for residential and commercial companies.

Being inspired by Bahamian parents, Elijah and Beatrice Russell, who farmed in Pompano Beach for George Banks in the vicinity presently known as Banks Road located in Pompano Beach, Florida, Bishop Russell, his wife Cosette Russell and children envisioned a life in farming. During the time period of 1949-1970 the vison became a reality. Bishop Russell began farming (beans, peppers, squash, eggplants, ctc.) on leased land located in the area of Federal Highway (US1) and Copans Road. The family also farmed in the area of Dixie Highway and S.W. Second Street in Pompano Beach, FL.

Bishop Russell was an active member of Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church who was subsequently licensed as a minister. After serving other denominations, he was called by his first congregation to be the Founder and Bishop of **Fire Baptism and Truth Church, Inc.,** of Pompano Beach, FL. The church was birthed in 1966 and established in 1972 with the belief based on biblical scripture. Within six months of Bishop Russell's tenure, the congregation grew from eight to fifty members and continued to grow and became a beacon of Christian light within the community of Pompano Beach. From 1985 to 2000 under the leadership of Bishop Russell four churches were added in two states. Adults and children from all walks of life experienced the true meaning of love, acceptance and the anointing of the Holy Spirit. Bishop Russell remained a Pioncer and faithful servant of God Almighty until his demise on April 22, 2014 at the age of 92.
