**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING
THE MAYOR TO EXTEND CERTAIN EMERGENCY
ORDERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Section 258.38(4)(c), Florida Statutes, as amended by Senate Bill 2006 in the 2021 legislative session, now provides that emergency orders not issued in response to a hurricane or other weather-related emergency may be extended by a majority vote of the governing body of the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, this requirement for renewal of emergency orders is a cumbersome process and thus does not best serve the needs of city residents; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach hereby authorizes the Mayor, or Vice-Mayor in his absence, to extend emergency orders not issued in response to a hurricane or other weather-related event, as required.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
