**SUBJECT:** Piggyback Musco Sports Lighting, LLC-Community Park Softball Fields.

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**Background:**

This project involves replacing (16) deteriorating light fixtures and upgrading the lighting and equipment for the softball fields at Community Park. Additionally, the existing pole grounding and lighting protection will be upgraded to meet current codes and regulations. The new lighting will be mounted on existing poles and will offer improved performance, including guaranteed light levels of 50 foot-candles infield, 30 foot-candles outfield, and uniformity. The new lighting system will also feature BallTracker™ technology, which optimizes visibility of the ball in play without causing glare in the players' line of sight. The system will be controlled and monitored using the Control-Link® system, which provides remote on/off and dimming control as well as performance monitoring with 24/7 customer support. With the new lighting system, energy costs are expected to be reduced by up to 20% compared to the existing equipment.

Staff would like to utilize the Clay County, Various Equipment and Amenities for Parks & Playgrounds Contract with Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, in order to procure these services for the project. Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, has been used on previous City projects, including Kester Park, McNair Park & Mitchell Moore Park and has performed very well.

**Recommendation:**

Utilizing the mentioned Piggyback contract, staff recommends approval of the Agenda item in order to execute an agreement with Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, in the amount of \$615,000.00.
