A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE NE 10TH STREET COMPLETE STREETS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) approved the Broward Complete Streets Master Plan on July 9, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the NE 10th Street Complete Streets Improvement Project, on NE 10th Street from N. Dixie Highway to N. Federal Highway will be evaluated and ranked by the MPO, then vetted to determine programmability in accordance to the CSLIP policies; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the Pompano Beach City Commission stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility; and

WHEREAS, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered using the federally mandated Local Agency Program (LAP) process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach commits to administer and deliver the project under LAP; and

WHEREAS, the LAP program is reimbursement based as specified in the LAP agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach commits to funding upfront costs for design, Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services, and construction to be then reimbursed as per the LAP agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach commits to program funding for construction contingency per the requirements of LAP; and

WHEREAS, the NE 10th Street Complete Streets Improvement Project, from N. Dixie Highway to N. Federal Highway will be constructed within the City of Pompano Beach's right of way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of City of Pompano Beach to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways after the project's completion; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The City supports this Complete Street Project, as listed on the attached Exhibit "A," to improve conditions for bicyclists and pedestrians.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall	l become effective upon passage.
