RESOLUTION

PROPOSED SITE DEVELOPMENT OF DAVE THOMAS EAST EDUCATION CENTER

NO: 26-114

WHEREAS, The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC), as the controlling body of the district schools of Broward County, Florida, owns, operates, and maintains various facilities and sites throughout Broward County, including elementary, middle, high schools, vocational sites, training facilities and equipment, and vacant lands; and

WHEREAS, SBBC is the owner of a 2.8485-acre real property, located at 180 SW 2nd Street, Pompano Beach, Florida 33060, also known as Dave Thomas East Education Center (hereafter referenced as "Center:); and

WHEREAS, SBBC operated the Center as an alternative educational facility from School Years 2017-2018 to 2019-2020, and whereby, in order to make repairs to the Center, the students attending the Center were relocated to another SBBC owned facility; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, it was determined that the facility had extensive structural issues, and therefore, any further attempts to repair the facility would be economically unwise. Thereafter, a Castaldi was conducted on the facility, and the conclusions in the Castaldi Report recommended that the facility should be demolished. Subsequently, the Castaldi Report was submitted to the Florida Department of Education (FDOE), where it is currently pending the FDOE's; review; and

WHEREAS, SBBC is the largest employer in Broward County, and has a large workforce. However, housing in Broward County is increasingly becoming expensive and unaffordable, and is presumably impacting SBBC's ability to retain its workforce and attract new personnel into its workforce; and

WHEREAS, SBBC desires to retain its workforce and attract new personnel into its workforce. As such, SBBC takes the position that it is prudent to redevelop the 2.8485-acre land occupied by the Center as residential workforce housing units and subsequently make them available to SBBC qualified employees to reside in; and in furtherance of this position, SBBC publicly discussed this intent at the June 10, 2025, School Board workshop; and

WHEREAS, in alignment with the information presented and discussed at the workshop, SBBC agrees that the residential workforce housing units developed on the site should be compatible with the surrounding residential developments, have a robust community ambience, and with a balanced density, to ensure its long-term sustainability; and

WHEREAS, SBBC hereby commits and directs that the residential workforce housing units shall be developed via the implementation of a public, private, partnership mechanism; and

WHEREAS, SBBC hereby commits to work cooperatively and collaboratively with the City of Pompano Beach to achieve SBBC's position stated herein in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED by the School Board of Broward County, Florida as follows:

SECTION 1. The School Board hereby supports the development of residential

workforce housing units on the 2.8485-acre Dave Thomas East Education

Center site.

SECTION 2. The School Board hereby requires that one hundred percent (100%) of the

residential workforce housing units should be made available and occupied by qualified Broward County Public Schools employees.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
