Re: Broward County FY 2025 rate increases and impact to City of Pompano Beach wastewater

rates

In 2023 Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. worked with the City of Pompano Beach (City) to develop water, wastewater, reuse, and stormwater rate adjustments for FY 2025 through FY 2029. Based on information known at that time, the rate adjustments for the wastewater utility were recommended as follows:

However, in a letter from Broward County (County) dated July 17, 2024, the County presented its rate adjustments for wholesale wastewater treatment service for FY 2025. The rates for FY 2025 for wastewater treatment include a volumetric rate increase of 14.8% and a decrease of 0.2% in the fixed rate component. The rate increases combined result in an overall increase in the City's wastewater treatment costs of **8.4%**, **or approximately \$1 million dollars**. Because of the higher than anticipated increases in wastewater treatment costs, the City's original 4% increase will be insufficient to meet the operating and capital needs of the wastewater utility. Instead, the rate increase needs to be increased from 4% to 7.5% from FY 2025 to FY 2029. Since the 4% increase in wastewater rates will be implemented in a few days (October 1, 2024), it is recommended *an additional* increase of 3.5% be implemented on January 1, 2025. The remaining 7.5% increases should take place on October 1<sup>st</sup> of each fiscal year as shown below. The

impacts for the average single-family customer using 8,000 gallons of water per month are also shown below.
