





Attached is the HID Application as well as an updated resume.

As proof of my residence in Pompano Beach, my utility account number is 174767-33210. My voter registration and Florida Drivers License also state my above address.

Of my vast employment history, the two elements that would contribute most to a position on the Hillsboro Inlet District would be my 1. Lobbying efforts with City of Miami and Dade County representing Marina developments and State-owned bottom land issues during the Eighties and Nineties. 2. As the Dir of The Historic Seaport for the City of Key West which included the renovation of the City owned property at Key West Bight 200 slip marina and all the upland grounds that stretched from the USCG Station to The Truman Annex and Mallory Square as well as the Garrison Bight 250 slip Marina. The related issues to HID would be the financial and management of a \$6 million-dollar annual operating budget and the \$22 million dollar renovation project budget of the upland buildings and grounds.

A major element was the bottom land issues with the State during marina development and Federal & State environmental reporting of monthly water pollution conditions during both marina renovations.

As the USCG Lodge Host at Hillsboro I had daily interaction with the HID dredge operators and staff. I often had conversations with Jack Holland regarding the sand migration issues and the HID cooperation maintaining the north Inlet beach as a buffer for the Lighthouse structure after severe weather events. I am more than aware of the outside pressures regarding the beach restoration north and south of the inlet as well as the channel maintenance.

Since I am in exceptionally good health, being semi-retired and my oil and gas business requires little of my personal attention, I can devote whatever attention is necessary to contribute to the HID Commission as valued team member. I look forward to an In-person or video interview at your or the Commission's pleasure.
