A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY'S FISCAL SUSTAINABILITY PLAN FOR THE GATEWAY DRIVE STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, RELATING TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF); PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes provide for loans to local government agencies to finance the construction of stormwater facilities; and Florida Administrative Code requires the formal authorization by City Commission to formally adopt a Fiscal Sustainability Plan outlining necessary stormwater improvements to comply with State of Florida funding requirements; and

WHEREAS, formal adoption of the proposed Fiscal Sustainability Plan is required for the City of Pompano Beach to participate in the State Revolving Loan Fund Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach, Florida, agrees with the findings and summary of necessary improvements as outlined in the Fiscal Sustainability Plan for the purpose of stormwater improvements for Gateway Drive; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are incorporated by reference and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby approves and adopts the City of Pompano Beach Fiscal Sustainability Plan.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby designated as the authorized representative to provide the assurances and commitments that will be required by the Fiscal Sustainability Plan.

SECTION 4. The Mayor is hereby designated as the authorized representative to execute the Fiscal Sustainability Plan, which will become the foundation of all activities related to the stormwater improvements. The Mayor is authorized to represent the City in carrying out the City's responsibilities under the Fiscal Sustainability Plan. The Mayor is authorized to delegate responsibility to appropriate city staff to carry out technical, financial, and administrative activities associated with the Fiscal Sustainability Plan.

SECTION 5. The legal authority for adoption of this Fiscal Sustainability Plan is pursuant to the City Charter, City Code of Ordinances, and the Laws of the State of Florida.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall be	ecome effective upon passage.
