Re: Name changes for NW 6<sup>th</sup> St and Hillsboro Inlet Park

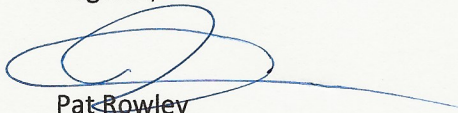
The Pompano Beach Historical Society Board has researched and discussed these requests and has come to the following conclusions:
