**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND BROWARD COUNTY FOR SURTAX-FUNDED TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS ALONG RIVERSIDE DRIVE FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO NE 14TH STREET; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE ANY NONMATERIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Broward County voters approved a 30-year sales surtax (also known as “Penny for Transportation”) to fund statutorily-permissible transportation expenditures in November, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the Riverside Drive Improvements Project was evaluated for eligibility under Section 212.055(1), Florida Statutes, by the independent Transportation Surtax Oversight Board and later approved for surtax funding by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** That an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Broward County for Surtax-funded Transportation Improvements along Riverside Drive from Atlantic Boulevard to NE 14<sup>th</sup> Street, is approved, and a copy of the Agreement is attached and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full.

**SECTION 2.** That the proper City officials are authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Broward County.

**SECTION 3.** The City Commission authorizes the City Manager and City Attorney to execute any nonmaterial amendments to the Interlocal Agreement.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
