A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NW 7<sup>TH</sup> STREET BETWEEN NW 31<sup>ST</sup> AVENUE AND NW 24<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF NW 7<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND HATTIE KIMBROUGH WILLIAMS WITH NW 7<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by Hattie Kimbrough Williams, a Pompano Beach resident, by adding the name "Hattie Kimbrough Williams Street" to a portion of NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** That the designation of a portion of NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street lying between NW 31<sup>st</sup> Avenue and NW 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue shall have the dual designation of NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street and "Hattie Kimbrough Williams Street," with NW 7<sup>th</sup> Street to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.
