A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING POMPANO BEACH RESOLUTION NO. 95-112 AND RESOLUTION NO. 2016-180 BY AMENDING SECTION 3, MEMBERSHIP, TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission established the Education Advisory Committee in Resolution No. 95-112 without the provision for alternate members; subsequent Resolution No. 2016-180 provided for two alternate members; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission now wishes to provide for additional alternate membership to the Education Advisory Committee; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of City of Pompano Beach Resolution No. 2016-180 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Membership.

. . .

The City Commission shall appoint two (2) alternate members of the Education Advisory Committee, who are residents of the City, to be designated as Alternate 1 and Alternate 2. Each alternate shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years, said terms to run concurrently. Alternate members shall be subject to removal for cause by the City Commission. Alternate member vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member. Should a temporary absence or disqualification of any member of the Education Advisory Committee occur, the Chairman of the Committee shall have the right and authority to designate one of the alternate members to serve as a substitute member during the continuance of

such absence or disqualification. The Chairman shall rotate such assignments between the alternate members to the extent that availability of alternate members allows.

Effective upon passage of this Resolution, the terms of service of currently serving substitute members of the Education Advisory Committee shall terminate. The Mayor and each member of the City Commission shall appoint one (1) alternate member of the Education Advisory Committee who are residents of the city. Each alternate shall serve for a term equal to and during the term of the elected official who appointed them, but shall continue to serve until replaced by another appointee. Alternate members shall be subject to removal for cause by the City Commission. Should a temporary absence or disqualification of any member of the Education Advisory Committee occur, the alternate appointed by the same elected official who appointed the unavailable committee member shall temporarily serve as a substitute member in his or her stead. The Chairman of the Committee shall have the right and authority to designate another alternate member to serve as a substitute member should the alternate member designated above be unavailable to serve.

SECTION 2. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby revoked.

SECTION 4. This Resolution sha	ll become effective upon passage.
