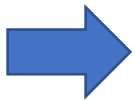

D. Presentations

a) Hola Mundo Proposal

Adriane Chambliss the camp director of Hola Mundo Camp, her campers and Leila Thompson (the artist) gave a presentation requesting the Public Art Committee recommend approval to temporarily display an artwork the camp is creating on Pompano Beach property. The Hola Mundo Beach and Surf Camp: *Turning the Trash into Art* artwork was proposed to be temporary displayed at 100 Pompano Beach Blvd. The program is an immersive summer camp experience for campers to work with topics of environmental concern such as plastic pollution as well as participate in a collaborative art project. The Committee was approached by the Hola Mundo Beach and Surf Camp with the proposal to display an artwork created out of plastic straws. The artwork, which is not yet finished, will be a wave made out of plastic straws, which will be on two (2), four (4) feet by two (2) feet panels - all together eight (8) feet wide. The campers will write a short description on how harmful plastic straws are to the ocean. The tentative date of completion is mid-July, 2019.



MOTION was made by Mr. Miller that the Public Art Committee will temporarily display and hold a celebration ceremony for the Hola Mundo Beach and Surf Camp: *Turning the Trash into Art* artwork.
