A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, URGING ALL MEMBERS OF THE FLORIDA STATE LEGISLATURE TO SUPPORT SENATE BILL 562, AMENDING SECTION 386.209, FLORIDA STATUTES, AUTHORIZING MUNICIPALITIES AND COUNTIES TO REGULATE SMOKING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF CERTAIN PUBLIC PARKS AND DESIGNATED FACILITIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, scientific studies, including studies by the Surgeon General of the United States and studies commissioned and assessed by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency have shown that exposure to breathing second-hand smoke is a significant health hazard to non-smokers; particularly to children, older persons, individuals with cardiovascular disease, and individuals with impaired respiratory function, including asthmatics and those with obstructive airway disease; and

WHEREAS, air pollution caused by smoking is an offensive annoyance and irritant, and smoking results in serious and significant physical harm to non-smokers even in outdoor public places; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach is the owner of the Pompano Beach public beach, an outdoor public facility; and

WHEREAS, in 2018 the Florida Senate convened the Committee on Community Affairs whose mission included addressing regulation of smoking preempted to state; and

WHEREAS, municipalities and counties may not restrict smoking within the boundaries of any public parks they own; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to support Senate Bill 562 in the 2018 Legislative Session; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO

BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as

being true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach hereby supports and

respectfully requests the adoption of legislation in the 2018 Legislature Session, specifically

Senate Bill 562, which would amend Section 386.209, Florida Statutes to allow municipalities

to restrict smoking within the boundaries of any public park and facility they own, and

encourages the Florida Legislature to adopt legislation to provide the necessary authorization and

regulation therefore.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is directed to distribute this Resolution to the Governor,

the President of the Florida Senate, the Speaker of the Florida House of Representatives, the

Broward County Legislative Delegation, the Florida League of Cities, the Florida Association of

Counties, the Florida City County Management Association, the Broward County League of

Cities, and each of the municipalities within Broward County.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
