A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, OFFERING A TEMPORARY PARKING CITATION AMNESTY PROGRAM FORGIVING LATE FEES FOR DELINQUENT CITATIONS DURING A 61-DAY PERIOD PRIOR TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BARNACLE IMMOBILIZATION SYSTEM; SETTING REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPANTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in light of the financial impact and hardship of the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Pompano Beach desires to remove parking citation late fees before deploying a parking immobilization system, known as the Barnacle Immobilization System, on August 10, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this is to give notice to those who would qualify for the Barnacle Immobilization System; and

WHEREAS, violators that participate in this program will have citation late fees removed and only the original fees shall be assessed; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City hereby establishes a Parking Citation Late Fee Amnesty Program.

SECTION 2. That participation in the Parking Citation Late Fee Amnesty Program shall be available for violators who have parking citations with late fees outstanding, with those persons only paying the original citation fines assessed during the period the program is in effect.

SECTION 3. The Parking Citation Late Fee Amnesty Program set forth above, shall be effective only for the time period beginning June 10, 2021, and ending at the close of business on August 9, 2021, and all citations eligible under the terms herein, enter into a written agreement on a form provided by the City, and that said agreement and payment from said eligible citations must be received by the City within said time period specified above for the Program, or the original citation amount and assessed late fees shall reinstate, minus any amounts paid.

SECTION 4. The City of Pompano Beach Parking Office shall operate the program and ensure all program requirements have been met, including all fees assessed and receipt of proper payment.

SECTION 5. This Resolution sha	all become effective upon passag	e.
