Exhibit ___ Scope of Services

A. Introduction

The City of Pompano Beach is commissioning Brodin Studios, Inc. (ARTIST) for the design and installation of a bronze bust of Mrs. Hazel Armbrister and pedestal that will be located in the Historic Ali Cultural Arts, 353 Dr Martin Luther King Blvd, Pompano Beach, FL 33060. A Call to Artists was posted on May 4, 2022, with a deadline of June 8, 2022. Twenty-nine (29) applications were submitted. On August 18, 2022, the Public Art Committee (PAC) selected Brodin Studios, Inc. as the recommended artist.

B. Objective

To continue to beautify and enhance the City of Pompano Beach and honor the late Mrs. Hazel Armbrister.

C. Scope of Work

ARTIST shall work with PAC to create a design for the Hazel Armbister bust and pedestal using reference images provided by PAC. Design sketches will be presented to PAC for review and approval thirty (30) days after the Agreement is fully executed. ARTIST will work directly with PAC to make any modification of the design prior to fabrication. ARTIST and PAC have an additional thirty (30) days to complete any modifications to the design. Once approval is received, ARTIST will fabricate the design. ARTIST will ensure that the design is code compliant and will stand up to South Florida weather conditions and wind load requirements. A plaque, provided by the Pompano Beach Historical Society must be placed on the pedestal. The City will provide a cement pad for the artwork.

D. Summary Schedule

This Agreement is for one (1) year after full execution by both parties. ARTIST will commence the design process of the artwork and begin the project within fifteen (15) business days after the Agreement is fully executed and will have eight (8) months to complete the design, fabrication, and installation. ARTIST will work directly with the Public Art Committee to create the design and must receive approval before moving forward with fabricating the artwork.

E. PROJECT LOCATION

The sculpture will be located in the courtyard of the Historic Ali Cultural Arts, 353 Dr. Martin Luther King Blvd.
