**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA,
SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING A SUBMITTAL
FOR TRANSPORTATION SURTAX FUNDING;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Broward County citizens approved by referendum the Transportation Surtax (“Penny for Transportation” Program) on November 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Broward County, the Municipalities, and the Broward Metropolitan Organization (MPO) entered the Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement, passed by Resolution No. 2018-275, and subsequently amended by Resolution Nos. 2019-239 and 2021-58, which provided for a cooperative and organized process for the Municipalities to submit projects for evaluation and funding with Surtax proceeds; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the City of Pompano Beach City Commission stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility with Surtax dollars; and

WHEREAS, officials of City of Pompano Beach feel that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Pompano Beach to endorse said project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach commits to administer and deliver the project under the terms of the Surtax Project Funding Agreement and Broward County Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the East Atlantic Streetscape Improvement Project (Cypress Rd. to NE/SE 18th Ave.) will be constructed within the City of Pompano Beach right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of City of Pompano Beach to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the project after its completion; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Pompano Beach hereby endorses the East Atlantic Boulevard Streetscape Improvement Project (Cypress Rd. to NE/SE 18th Ave.) and will provide technical assistance when available and needed for the duration of the project.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
