A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NW 27TH AVENUE WITH SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF ATLANTIC BLVD. AND NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF NW 16TH STREET TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF REV EVANDER DERICO SR AVENUE, WITH NW 27TH AVENUE TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by Rev. Evander Derico Sr., a longtime Pompano Beach resident by dual naming NW 27th Avenue and “Rev. Evander Derico Sr Avenue”, with NW 27th Avenue to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA;

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of Northwest 27th Avenue lying between the southern boundary of Atlantic Blvd. and northern boundary of NW 16th Street shall have the dual designation of Northwest 27th Avenue and Rev. Evander Derico Sr, with NW 27th Avenue, to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
