**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING
THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
BUILD ALTERNATIVES FOR THE WIDENING OF
FLORIDA’S TURNPIKE FROM SOUTH OF ATLANTIC
BOULEVARD TO WILES ROAD AND THE
IMPROVEMENTS TO THE COCONUT CREEK
PARKWAY INTERCHANGE; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach has many businesses and residents that rely on the South Florida regional transportation network; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Turnpike is a key link in that transportation network; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (Department) has done extensive work in developing and evaluating alternatives to address both local and regional needs; and

WHEREAS, the Department has facilitated extensive public engagement and has explained the alternatives, solicited input, and incorporated changes throughout the study; and

WHEREAS, the Department presented Build Alternatives that address the purpose and need of the project including three Build Alternatives to widen the Florida Turnpike from south of Atlantic Boulevard to Wiles Road and two Build Alternatives to improve the Coconut Creek Parkway interchange;

WHEREAS, the Department has evaluated the positive and negative impacts of each alternative, and has also considered a No-Build Alternative.

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach supports the alternative that widens the Florida Turnpike from south of Atlantic Boulevard to Wiles Road within existing state right-of-way, and

either of the Build Alternatives to improve the Coconut Creek Parkway interchange, since the alternatives will improve and enhance the transportation network that is relied upon by both our residents and businesses; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The City supports the Florida Department of Transportation Build Alternatives for Florida's Turnpike.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the Florida Department of Transportation.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
