**CITY OF POMPANO BEACH
Broward County, Florida**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 132, "PUBLIC PEACE AND SAFETY," OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REPEALING SECTION 132.15, "UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY"; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, ten (10) days' notice has been given by publication in a paper of general circulation in the City, notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Pompano Beach; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Commission was held pursuant to the published notice described above, at which hearing the parties in interest and all other citizens so desiring had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; now, therefore,

WHEREAS, the defined conduct and penalty associated therewith provided for in Section 132.15 entitled, "Unlawful Assembly," of Chapter 132, "Public Peace and Safety," of the City of Pompano Beach Code of Ordinances is already addressed in Chapter 870, Florida Statute, and therefore the City Ordinance would only be duplicative of the state statute and thus is unnecessary;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 132.15 entitled, "Unlawful Assembly," of Chapter 132, "Public Peace and Safety," of the City of Pompano Beach Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed in its entirety;

SECTION 2. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
