Text Amendments to Ch. 156, Sign Code

Recommended revision to Table 156.09: Standards for Temporary Signs

At the February 22, 2017 Planning and Zoning Board hearing, Staff addressed comments and concerns related to the proposed standards for Temporary Signs. A concern was raised about the 45-day limit for real estate signs. Staff reviewed the concern with the City Attorney's office and outside counsel. As a result, Staff is recommending the following revision to Table 156.09: Standards for Temporary Signs (Page 46). The revision would allow real estate signs to remain on the property as long as the property is for sale (rent or lease) and would need to be removed within 7 days of the sale. This change does not impact the Ordinance title.
