## CITY OF POMPANO BEACH Broward County, Florida

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-45 TO MODIFY EXHIBIT 'A," LEGAL DESCRIPTION, TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL AREAS IN THE ABANDONMENT OF THOSE CERTAIN UTILITY EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY WITHIN THE FERNANDER/WRIGHT SUBDIVISION RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 159, PAGE 6 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, LYING NORTH OF NORTHWEST 15<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND WEST OF ROBERT MARKHAM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** Ordinance No. 2005-45 was approved on April 26, 2005, by the City Commission for the abandonment of that certain easements and rights-of-way within the Fernander/Wright Subdivision recorded in Plat Book 159, Page 6 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida, lying north of Northwest 15<sup>th</sup> Street and west of Robert Markham Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the property owner/applicant now requires that certain minor adjustments be made to the original legal description to include additional portions of property as part of the abandonment; now, therefore,

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to law, ten (10) days' notice has been given by publication in a paper of general circulation in the City, notifying the public of this proposed Ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Pompano Beach; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Commission was held pursuant to the published notice described above, at which hearing the parties in interest and all other citizens so desiring had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; and

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** That the City of Pompano Beach approves and accepts the modified Exhibit "A," to Ordinance No. 2005-45, a copy of which Legal Description is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Clerk is hereby instructed to record this Ordinance in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.

**SECTION 3.** If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

<b>SECTION 4.</b> This Ordinance shall become effective	apon passage.
