5. <u>DISCUSSION ON DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO 155.5302 – FENCES</u> <u>AND WALLS</u>

This is to discuss a draft text amendment compiled by staff that includes several minor amendments to this section.

NOTE: See above for Board discussion for both agenda items #4 and #5.

6. <u>TEXT AMENDMENTS TO ZONING CODE</u>

Staff is recommending a text amendment in order to add a use-specific standards. The new standard applies city-wide to City and CRA owned/leased property, ensuring that these publicly owned spaces are open, safe and accessible to people of all ages.

Mr. Keester-O'Mills stated that the City is proposing to add a new standard that will be applicable to City or CRA properties so that any such facility that is open to the general public would prohibit certain groups depending on the kind of event. For example, a cigar show or liquor show would have to prohibit the attendance of minors.

Mr. Stacer asked for clarification that a vendor on public property would not be precluded from selling alcohol.

Mr. Keester-O'Mills confirmed this.

Mr. Hill asked if this means that minors would be prohibited from attending the gun show at the Emma Lou Olsen center.

Mr. Keester-O'Mills confirmed this. He clarified, however, that this would not only be about gun shows but would extend to other kinds of events as well.

Ms. Eaton asked if this would hypothetically impact alcohol use at the the civic center for a wedding reception.

Mr. Keester-O'Mills responded that it would not because the consumption of alcohol is not impacted by this amendment.

Ms. Jackson asked again about the consumption of alcohol at events.

Mr. Keester-O'Mills reiterated that the consumption of alcohol at special events would not be impacted by this.

MOTION by Tony Hill and second by Joan Kovac to recommend approval of the text amendments as proposed by staff. All voted in favor.
