SUBJECT: Award Recommendation for P-28-18 WTP Transfer Station Rehabilitation

This project will replace and update all electrical and pumping equipment located within the Transfer Pump Station at the Water Plant. All of it was constructed, installed and placed online in 1985 and is at the end of the service life.

In addition to the Transfer Station rehabilitation work, Utilities has included replacement of five Membrane Plant feed pump variable frequency drives (VFDs) identified on the Capital Outlay List and power supply work to the Utilities Field Operations Building, in order to provide emergency generator power. These items were included in this solicitation as a vehicle to accomplish this work at reduced pricing.

Bid solicitation P-28-18 WTP Transfer Station Rehabilitation was advertised and closed Friday October 5, 2018. There were two bid packages submitted by contractors. A bid of \$3,620,000 by Edwards Electric, Corporation and a bid of \$2,478,543.00 by All Florida Contracting Services, LLC. Both bids were reviewed by our consultant, who found them to be complete and meeting the experience requirements. All Florida Contracting Services, LLC was recommended as the lowest responsive bidder by our consultant.

Based upon the consultant's review and recommendation, Utilities concurs that All Florida Contracting Services, LLC be awarded P-28-18 WTP Transfer Station Rehabilitation for \$2,478,543.00 as the lowest responsive bidder.
