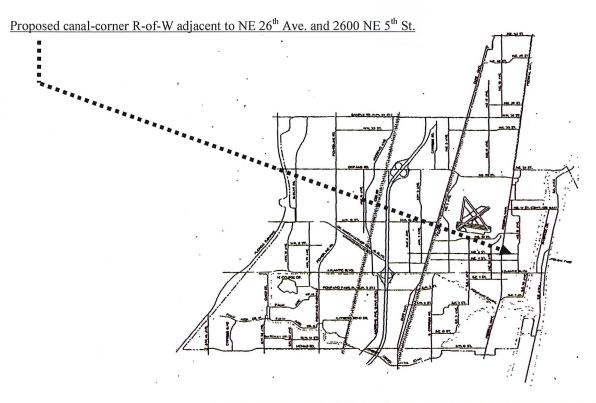

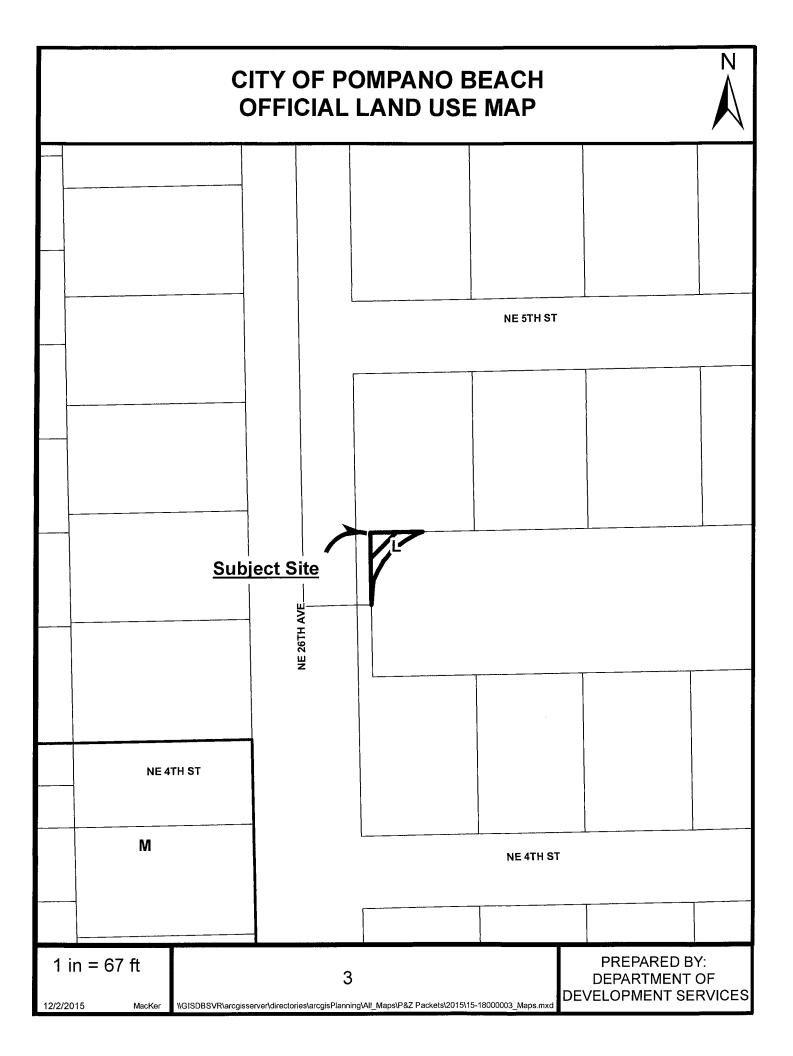
The City of Pompano Beach has conducted an analysis assessing the usage of various public rights-of way. The triangular canal-corner right-of-way adjacent to NE 26th Avenue and 2600 NE 5th Street was assessed as being eligible for abandonment, since it is not considered necessary for public usage. Therefore, the City is requesting abandonment of this right-of-way. Since this right-of-way had been dedicated by plat, if this request is ultimately approved by the City Commission, the property will revert to the lot owner to the north. The owner of that property has agreed to sign a "Right-of-Way Visibility Agreement" to ensure that the requirements of Section 155.5203B.2.a.ii. are met, so that the visibility of the canal is preserved.

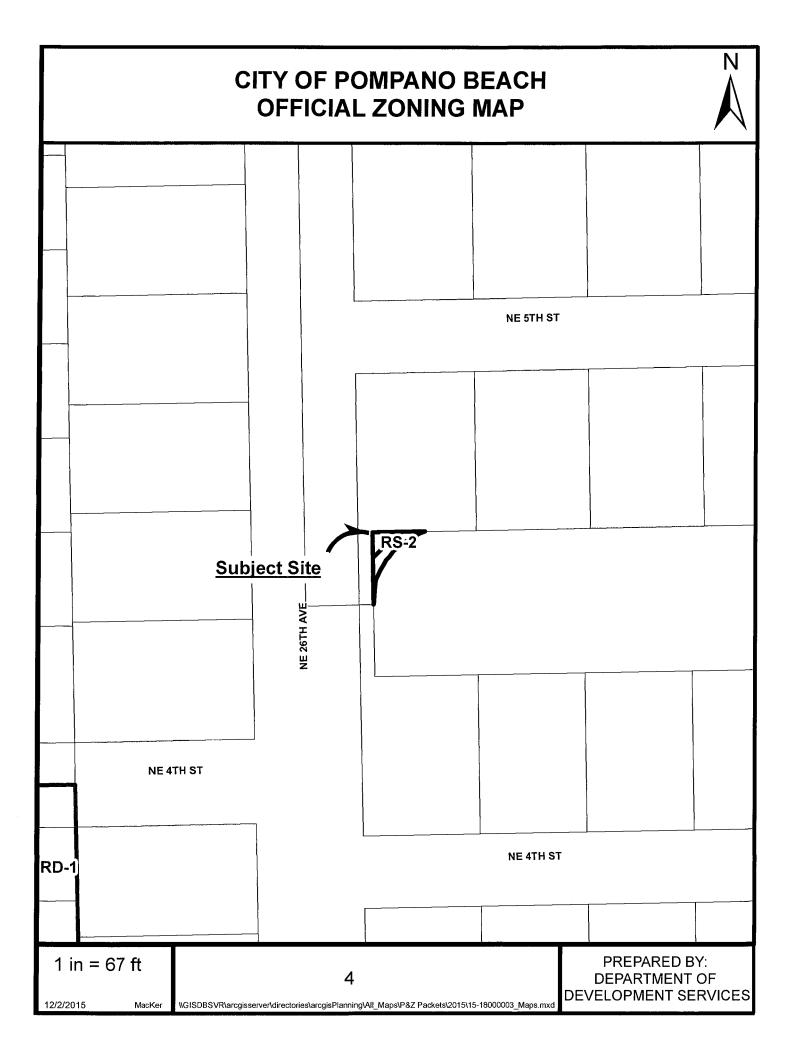

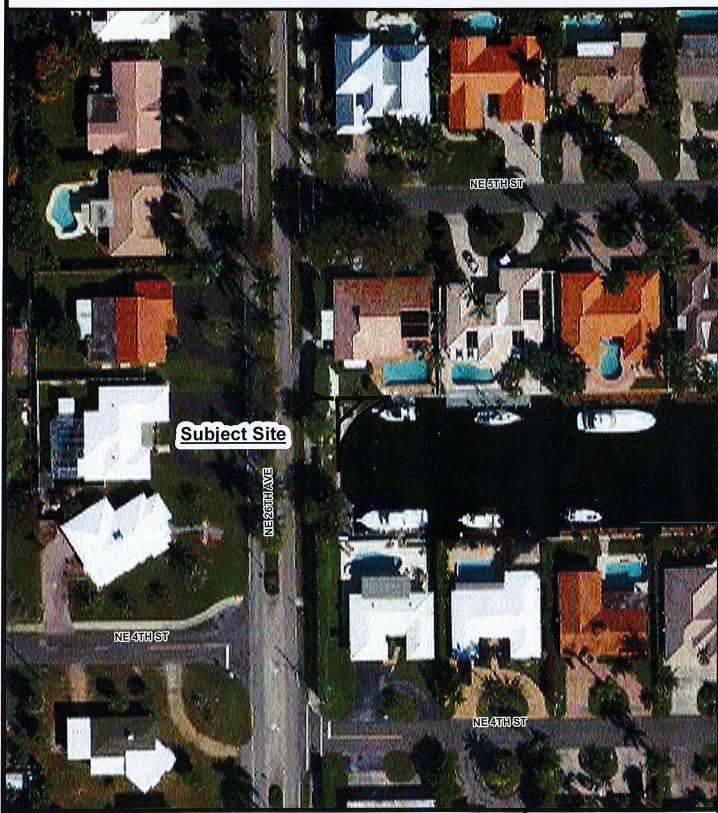

CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AERIAL MAP





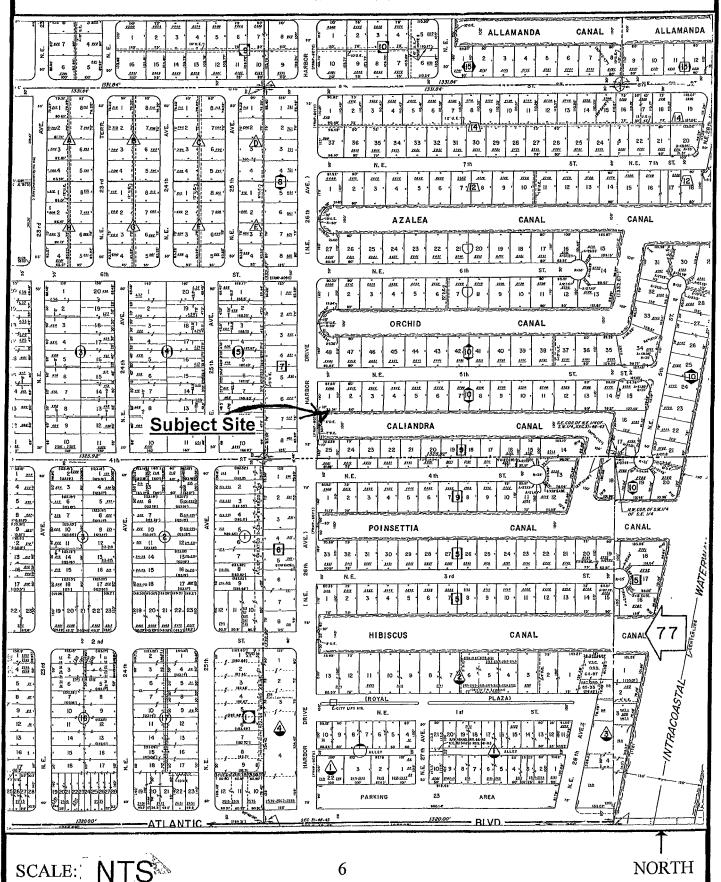

ZONING DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATION

- 2. This request will not be placed on a City Commission Agenda until the Applicant signs a "Right-of-Way Visibility Agreement that ensures that No Plant material shall be installed or maintained above 3 feet in height and no wall or fences shall be constructed or maintained within the sight visibility area (the subject property of this abandonment) per Section 155.5203B.2.a.ii.

III- Denial

Recommend denial to the City Commission as the Board finds that the right-of-way serves a public purpose and should not be abandoned.
