The meeting was held to evaluate the proposals received in response to the City's solicitation to establish a contract to provide Investment Management Services to the City. This meeting was posted as a "Public Meeting" both at City Hall and at the Purchasing Division office, and on the City's website. Eight (8) firms submitted acceptable responses to the City's Request for Proposals (RFP).

Andrew Jean-Pierre, Finance Director, led the technical discussion. The Purchasing Agent reviewed evaluation procedures, and distributed Conflict of Interest Statements for completion by all voting members. Each Committee member had reviewed all of the responses in advance of the meeting.

The Committee discussed each of the proposals in alphabetical order, and scored the responses using voting forms containing the evaluation criteria published in the RFP, with the following results:
