a.) Mosaic Mural

The mosaic mural budget is \$4,000.00 and the location is Kelly's Chemical & Janitorial Supplies (135 NE 1st Street, Pompano Beach, FL 33060). The City of Pompano Beach has not signed an Agreement with Kelly's Chemical & Janitorial as of yet, but they have agreed to allow the City to use their location.

Call to Artist was posted May 2, 2019 and the deadline was June 27, 2019. Fourteenth (14) applicants applied and five (5) were marked as incomplete submissions. After voting online through CAFÉ, applications were narrowed down to six (6) applications scoring 1.8 or higher.

Ms. Atria showed a slide show of the top six (6) artist entries.

The first (1st) artist was Lee Ciochella.

The Public Art Committee liked his piece, but felt the piece is designed to be on the ground.

The second (2nd) artist was Rosario Harker.

Mr. Davis stated he's not so sure with the piece, but he did liked the second piece.

Ms. Houston Jones stated the art piece looked dark.

The third (3rd) artist was Cindy Trezona.


Mr. Davis stated she did not provide great examples.
