<u>Issue</u>

Staff is seeking City Commission approval of a Resolution to enter into an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") with the Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA"). The ILA will allow the CRA to manage traffic engineering services to be provided by Kimley-Horn & Associates (KHA) as described in Work Authorization No. 1 (See Exhibit "A") in the sum of \$90,000.00 whereas the City Manager may approve a reimbursement to the CRA of up to \$45,000.00.

Recommendation

Staff recommends Approval of the Resolution.

Background

The City wishes to enter into an ILA with the CRA. The ILA is necessary to allow the CRA to manage a traffic engineering assignment to KHA via City's Work Authorization No. 1 and for the City to refund the CRA a sum not to exceeded \$45,000.00 for said professional services. KHA will assist the City and CRA to meet the requirements of the East Area Transit-Oriented Corridor (ETOC) Land Use Plan Amendment, primarily to address transportation issues in and around the boundaries of the ETOC and develop transportation systems management (TSM) improvements along Atlantic Boulevard and neighborhood protection/enhancements.

Staff recommends approval.
