A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE RESTRICTION OF TRUCK TRAFFIC ON NW 6<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AND THE INSTALLATION OF THE SIGNAGE REQUIRED FOR SUCH PURPOSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, NW 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue has a narrow roadway width due to traffic calming roundabouts south of NW 15<sup>th</sup> Street and no suitable outlet as it dead ends north of NW 15<sup>th</sup> Street; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has found that NW 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue has operational deficiencies and cannot adequately support truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Code Section 70.20 (A), the Chief of Police or his designee are authorized to take action to have NW 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Atlantic Blvd. north to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street posted with No Thru Truck (NTT) signs; now, therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission has approved and authorizes that truck traffic on NW. 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Atlantic Blvd. north to NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street shall be restricted and that the appropriate No Thru Truck signage shall be installed.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County Traffic Engineering Division, so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.
