A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NW 9TH COURT BETWEEN CHARLES DREW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ON THE WEST AND CHARLES DREW FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER ON THE EAST TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF LAMAR JACKSON COURT AND NW 9TH COURT WITH NW 9TH COURT TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition for the athletic accomplishment of winning the Heisman trophy in 2016 as a resident of Pompano Beach, by adding the name “Lamar Jackson Court” to a portion of NW 9th Court; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA;

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of NW 9th Court lying between Charles Drew Elementary School on the West and Charles Drew Family Resource Center on the east shall have the dual designation of “Lamar Jackson Court” and NW 9th Court, with NW 9th Court to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County, so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
