SUBJECT: Request for Resolution – FDOT Construction Agreement

Fire Station 11 Emergency Signalization.

Issue:

Staff is seeking City Commission approval for the City to enter in to a Construction Agreement with FDOT in order to complete the Fire Station 11 emergency signalization.

Background:

A Construction Agreement was entered into with FDOT and the City on October 30, 2012 (Exhibit B). The Construction Agreement was for the installation of an emergency traffic signal for Fire Station 11 on N.Ocean Blvd (AIA), which is in a FDOT right-a-way. The original scope of work was a part of the new construction of Fire Station 11. Due to the removal and change of the Contractor performing the work, the emergency signals were never installed and the emergency signal scope was removed from the Contractor who was finishing Fire Station 11. Due to the emergency signal not being completed, the previous Construction Agreement has expired.

In order to complete the new emergency signalization improvements, the City must enter into a new Construction Agreement with FDOT in order to be able to proceed with the construction of the emergency signalization. The current emergency signalization plans are in the process of being updated by the designer. The new scope of work will include (2) emergency traffic signals, minor curbing and sidewalk modification and pavement striping just east of Fire Station 11 on N.Ocean Blvd.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the Resolution. No cost is associated with this Resolution at this time.
