A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA ADOPTING THE MILLAGE FOR THE 2017 TAX ROLL; LEVYING A TAX ON ALL PROPERTIES, REAL AND PERSONAL, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF **POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY** DISTRICT, FOR **SERVICES OPERATION** AND/OR MAINTENANCE EXPENSES OF THE POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT USING A MILLAGE OF .5000; PROVIDING THAT THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE REPRESENTS AN 8.01% INCREASE IN COMPARED TO PROPERTY TAXES WHEN ROLLED-BACK RATE OF .4629; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the sum of \$6,043,913 for operation and/or maintenance expenses for the October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018 fiscal year must be raised by a tax levy on all non-exempt real and personal property within the limits of the Pompano Beach Emergency Medical Services District; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Broward County Property Appraiser that the assessed valuation of taxable property on the 2017 Tax Roll, after certain exemptions have been allowed, in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, amounts to the sum of \$12,087,825,751 for operation and/or maintenance expenses; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF POMPANO BEACH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pompano Beach

Emergency Medical Services District herewith levies 0.5000 mills on the total non-exempt

valuation of \$12,087,825,751 and the receipts from said levy are to be deposited in the Pompano

Beach Emergency Medical Services District Fund to be used for the operation and/or

maintenance expenses of the Pompano Beach Emergency Medical Services District for the

October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018 fiscal year.

SECTION 2. That the Board of Commissioners hereby finds and determines that such

levy of 0.5000 for operation and/or maintenance expenses represents an 8.01% increase in

property taxes.

SECTION 3. That such levy of 0.5000 be certified by the City Clerk to the Broward

County Property Appraiser by delivering a certified copy of this resolution so that such levy and

millage may be extended against all property located within the corporate limits of the Pompano

Beach Emergency Medical Services District, Broward County, Florida liable for taxation.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective upon passage.
