## **MEMORANDUM**

Please prepare a Resolution to approve and execute Amendment Number One of an existing Locally Funded Agreement ("LFA") with the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT"). The amendment will allow FDOT to commingle design and construction services on behalf of the City and all other participating municipalities related to improvements funded by a **Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery ("**TIGER") grant. The grant provides \$3.5 million towards work on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Hammondville Road) from I-95 to Powerline Road.

The City Commission has already approved Resolution 2017-173 (see Exhibit "A"), which authorized executing a LFA with FDOT. The proposed Amendment will allow FDOT to advertise a Request for Proposals (RFP) representing all participating municipalities including Pompano Beach. This will result in design and/or construction savings to the City of Pompano Beach.

This Resolution is requested to be added to the May 8, 2018 City Commission's agenda.
