Project NEON overview

The company has requested confidentiality via Florida Statute 288.075

This is an existing Pompano Beach company since 2010.

- They are a sport medicine products manufacturer.
- Looking to move manufacturing production from RI to FL.
- Prep and buildout of new manufacturing area to include FDA Class II workspace, employee prep area, WIP location and materials.
- FDA Class II water filtration system with infrared.
- Finished good(s) area.
- Adding Administrative and Executive offices (10,000 sf).

Increasing leased area by **20,000 sf industrial space** (10,000 sf office) off South Andrews Ave. Other relocation options include: Rhode Island or Massachusetts.

Will hire twelve (12) new-to-Florida FTE employees by December 31, 2018. The jobs are listed as (4) management and (8) operations positions. Also, twenty-two (22) jobs will be retained at the current location.

Total capital investment will be approximately \$2,729,000 in **year one**; those costs include: leased space, renovations, purchase of R&D and manufacturing equipment and additional office equipment.

Under the Qualified Targeted Industries incentive program, the company is eligible for up to \$3,000 per job + another \$2,000 per manufacturing job (High Impact Sector bonus) as long as they meet the appropriate salary level of \$55,990 (which is 115% the average county wage- 2016 figures most recent). They do, so that's \$5,000/job.

Incentive breakdown:
