MINUTES

A. New Projects

1. Mosaic Team

a. Charlotte Burrie Community Center

Laura Atria read the staff report #18-278.

The artist, Sonata Kazimieraitiene, gave a presentation of her proposed designs for the Charlotte Burrie Community Center. She presented three proposed designs for the Committee to review. The three options included small mosaics circles 2-3 inches in diameter that will be glazed, minimal amounts of glass, and clay. The total size of the mosaic mural will be 8' by 16'. It will be a project the community can get involved with and one that people of all ages and skills can work on. It is a representation of the community coming together and growing together. The idea is for the community to create it together so that there is a piece of art that is meaningful to them.

Mr. Miller stated the colors are beautiful but he does not see "community" when he looks at it. However, he understands how the community can get involved in the process.

Ms. Kazimieraitiene responded the message is that every person is an individual but together they are a community.

A vote was conducted with the second option, the Ripple, being the winner.



MOTION by David Miller and seconded by Mimi Botscheller to approve layout number 2, Ripples. Motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Atria stated this design proposal will need to go in front of the City Commission in September before it can officially be approved.
