As you may recall, the second reading of the Hidden Harbour Land Use Plan Amendment (LUPA) Ordinance (File ID: 16-32) was heard at the June 26th City Commission hearing, at which time the applicant requested a postponement to the September 11th meeting. A companion item to the LUPA was placed on the same agenda regarding staffing for evaculation shelters, and the Commission made a motion to postpone that item to be heard at the same time (File ID: 18-400). Since that time, the applicant held a neighborhood meeting on August 14, where approximately 70 people attended.

The applicant has requested another postponement to October 9, 2018, in order to have additional neighborhood meetings. I am attaching the email that was sent by the applicant. As requested by the Commission, staff will be advertising and sending out notifications to an enlarged circumference area before the item is heard by the Commission. Staff is recommending both of these items (Item 22 & 23) on the September 11th City Commission Agenda be postponed to October 9, 2018.
