The Russell Education Foundation's proposed program budget for the four Pompano Beach Russell Reading Program sites includes all direct program expenses plus an allocation of administrative and fundraising expenses. CDBG funding will be matched by private grants from the Jim Moran Foundation and the Libra Foundation, and additional funds will be raised through special events and other fundraising activities in order to support the full expense of program implementation.

Budget costs include the following:

- *Salaries and Wages: For six (6) Teachers and four (4) Site Directors. CDBG requested funding would cover the cost of three (3) Teachers and two (2) Site Directors. Additional funding will support the remaining teacher, site director and program evaluator salary expenses as well as a portion of the Vice President for Mission Advancement and Director of Programs salaries (allocated at approximately 22%)
- *Employee Benefits: Calculated at the organizational rate of 22% inclusive of FICA/MICA, Unemployment, Taxes, and Benefits.
- *Supplies/Educational Materials: Includes newly purchased books and workbooks aligned with Florida Standards Assessment benchmarks, reading folders, paper, pencils, books for student incentives/awards, and other materials for students.
- *Postage and Printing: Covers all costs relative to postage and copying materials for the RRP at the Pompano Beach sites.
- *Travel: Includes mileage expenses plus parking/tolls/maintenance for the Director of Program's weekly site visits.
- *Administrative Costs: Covers a percentage of rent for REF's administrative offices, utilities, insurance, legal fees, communication, and financial fees.
