Issue

Staff is seeking approval of a Resolution to enter into an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Broward County. The agreement is necessary to receive a full reimbursement for design and construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard and NW 27th Avenue.

Recommendation

Staff recommends Approval of the Resolution.

Background

For several years, the City has been seeking approval from Broward County Traffic Engineering (BCTED) to install a traffic signal at the intersection of NW 27th Avenue and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard. After months of discussions and design efforts, BCTED approved the installation of the signal and Broward County agreed to pay for all expenses including design, construction administration and construction work. The agreement will allow the City of Pompano Beach to piggyback on an existing Broward County contract # C1347414B1 and retain DP Development of the Treasure Coast, LLC., a Broward County approved contractor, to provide traffic signal installation services. Upon completion of all work, the City will submit an invoice to Broward County and be eligible for a total reimbursement amount of \$603,570.00. Staff intends to present a separate agenda item for City Commission approval piggybacking the aforementioned contract and awarding it to DP Development of the Treasure Coast, LLC.
