A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE CODE ENFORCEMENT AMNESTY PROGRAM AND MODIFYING PROCEDURES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach on December 10, 2019, approved Resolution No. 2020-78, granting a temporary period of partial amnesty for code enforcement liens and setting a reduction formula and schedule for payment of accrued code liens, and setting requirements for participants; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach wishes to grant an additional six months to the Code Enforcement Lien Amnesty Program with said program currently set to expire on August 18, 2020, and to modify procedures; now, therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** That the temporary Code Enforcement Lien Amnesty Program, approved by City Resolution No. 2020-78, is hereby extended for an additional six months through and including February 18, 2021.

**SECTION 2.** During the extension period, Amnesty Program participants have until the end of the program, on February 18, 2021, to submit <u>all payment</u> due to the City, or the original amount of the subject lien(s) will reinstate, minus any amounts paid. The Special Magistrate, upon good cause shown, may extend this payment deadline for up to ninety (90) days.

<b>SECTION 3.</b> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolu	tion are
repealed to the extent of such conflict.	
<b>SECTION 4.</b> This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
