SUBJECT: License Agreement Beachfest Entertainment LLC (Resolution 2019-224)

Dear Roy:

Per our Agreement, adopted by Resolution Number 2019-224 (Article 14 Notices and Demands), I am writing to officially notify you that the planned music festivals scheduled to take place on the City's main public beach are no longer viable options for the City and therefore are not being considered and the license agreement is hereby effectively rescinded. This decision is due to a number of issues including the COVID-19 Virus Pandemic this year, multiple unknowns surrounding a large-scale event after the pandemic, and other contributing factors. The City has elected to invoke its rights pursuant to Article 19 (Force Majeure) due to the ongoing crisis which is completely out of control of either party.

In an effort to close this matter, we hereby request a written response acknowledging Beachfest Entertainment LLC concurrence with the decision to rescind Resolution NO. 2019-224 effectively cancelling all music festivals and the license agreement in their entirety within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this correspondence. We are very much aware that the situation and conditions could change in subsequent years and welcome the opportunity to provide your company the opportunity to the right of first refusal if for any reason the conditions avail themselves for future consideration.
