SUBJECT: ABANDONMENT – Abandonment Request by for 3-Foot Utility Easement

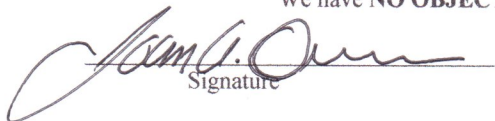
